## Scheduling a 2019 Spring Term Registration

**Appointment:** Beginning Saturday, September 29, 2018, Dual Enrollment students may go online to MyEFSC to schedule a spring term registration appointment for Monday, October 29<sup>th</sup> or after. *Appointment slots fill quickly and may be reserved only by using the online appointment tool. Students may not make an appointment by telephoning EFSC. Students must bring their **Dual Enrollment Registration form signed by their school counselor** and a photo ID to register.*

## Dual Enrollment

**Registration forms:** The EFSC online searchable 2019 Spring Term schedule should be available on Monday, October 1<sup>st</sup> on the EFSC website at <http://www.easternflorida.edu/academics/class-schedule-search.cfm>. **Students should contact** their counselor, **Mrs. Carroll** or **Mrs. Taylor** after **October 11<sup>th</sup>** by e-mail to set up a face-to-face appointment or phone appointment to discuss spring classes. **Students must request dual enrollment registration form at least 2**

**full school days before their EFSC registration appt.**

## How to schedule an Advising or Admissions Appointment?

1. Begin by logging into *myEFSC*.
2. Go to the EFSC Student Applications Section.
3. Use the drop down and select Student Services Appointments > click Launch

## Walk-in Registration begins Monday,

**November 5<sup>th</sup>:** Beginning Monday, November 5, 2018, students without an appointment may register for spring term classes by coming to their selected campus with their signed dual enrollment registration form and a photo ID. Students will be served on a first come, first served basis. Dual enrollment students are not assigned to a specific advisor.

**EFSC Books:** Fall books should be returned to the BVS office prior to winter break – no later than December 14<sup>th</sup>.  
Per the *Brevard Virtual Dual*

*Enrollment Student/Parent Agreement*, “The student will take responsibility for the textbooks and materials, **returning them to BVS within 7 days of the term ending.** This will allow BVS to issue them to other students.”

**Spring books will be issued on Wednesday & Thursday, December 19<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup>,** since **EFSC spring term begins on Monday, January 7,** while Brevard Virtual, and all Brevard Public schools, do not begin their spring semester until Thursday, January 10.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Monday, January 7, is the first day of classes for the EFSC spring term.

**ALSO NOTE:** To register for the dual enrollment courses for the next term, the student must be on pace in all high school classes, which means:

- Average pace in all high school classes is within 5% of the BVS target pace AND
- No course is more than 12% behind target pace.
